#### What has worked in other school districts

Here are four school districts who have invested in scheduling technology:

- Mesquite ISD (Dallas, TX:) Prioritized revisiting and restructuring their master schedules each year, building the special education schedule first each time.
- Noble Schools (Chicago, IL): Created "intervention blocks" for priorities including college preparedness, an ti-racism initiatives, and accelerated learning.
- Richardson ISD (Dallas, TX): Scheduled educational learning specialists within their own subject areas instead of spreading them across multiple subjects
- **Lubbock ISD (South Plains, TX)**: Leveraged "intervention rooms" so as not to interrupt classrooms, and always mentor new assistant principals on scheduling priorities.
