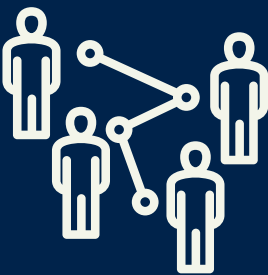
Programming that prioritizes interventions and staffing solutions

NJTC is a Tutor Apprenticeship Program. Apprenticeship programs train and support individuals within that occupation to become highly skilled. NJTC added post-secondary partners to help connect credit attainment for future teachers.

2023-2024

In math, the percent of students that were grade level proficient grew from 4% to 26%. In reading, the percent of student that were grade level proficient grew from 12% to 30%.

High Impact Tutoring

Evidence-based intervention to close learning gaps for students in Math and ELA. Programming can be after school or embedded during the school day. Tutors work with small groups of 1:3 at least 2x a week.

Upskill Existing Staff

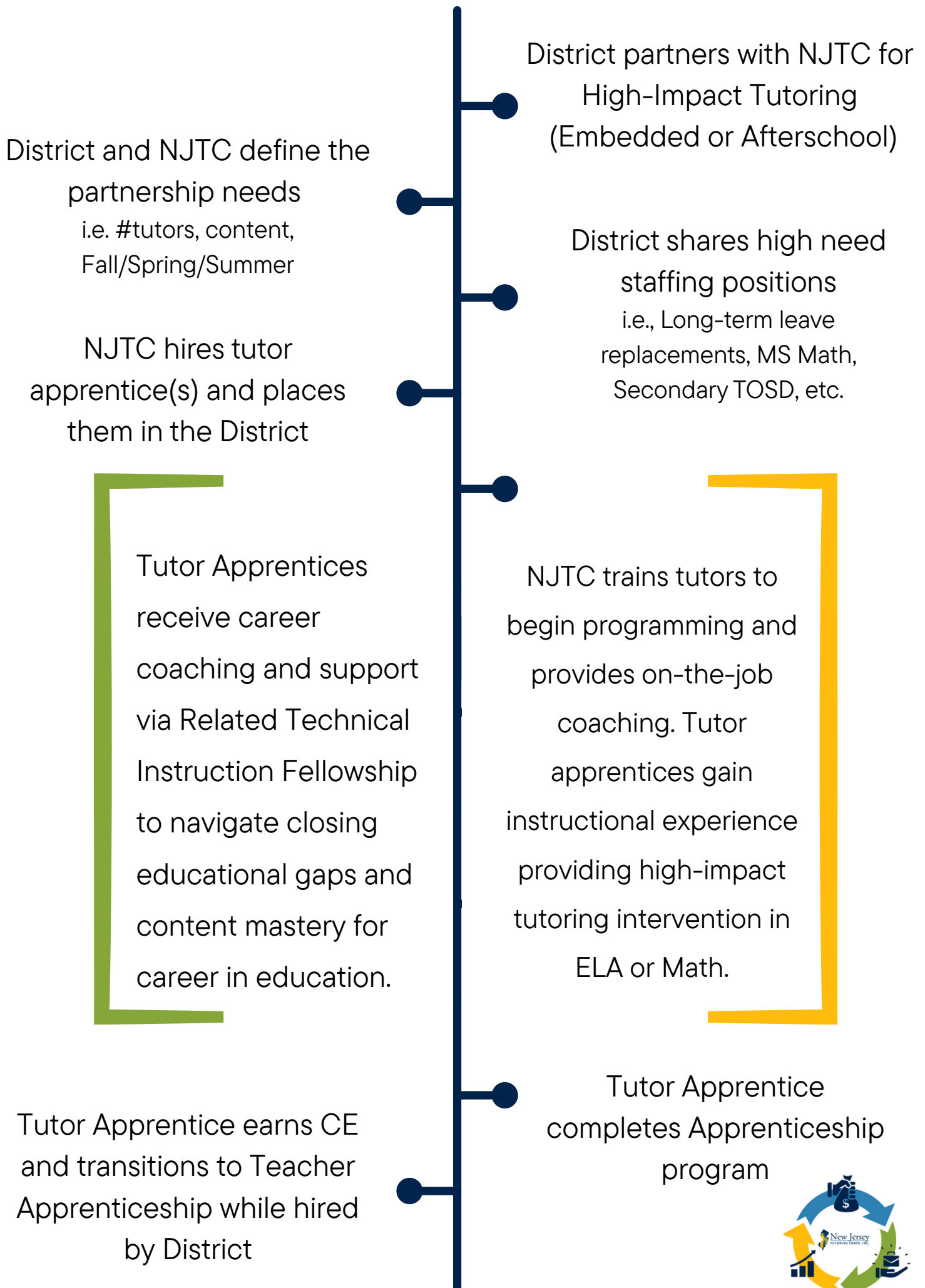
We can hire your paras or teaching assistants, and as they work as tutors, they can complete programming towards certification.
